Inaugural 'Beating the Bounds' walk, to include Highfield Moss perimeter

Start and finish: The Red Lion

Assemble 10:00: Red Lion car park

Full circuit: approximately three hours, with short 'briefing' stops

First stop: East Lancs lay-by (housing proposals)

Second stop: Golborne East Lancs railway bridge (what goes on?)

Third stop: Parkside Road (Parkside freight depot)

Fourth stop: Highfield Moss railway crossing (SSSI management)

Fifth stop: Highfield Moss ('Kenyon International' airstrip)

Sixth stop: off Winwick Lane (HGVs/wind turbine)

Seventh stop: Kenyon Lane (landscape/HGVs)

Red Lion - East Lancs - Warrington Road - Parkside Road - footpath - Highfield Moss - footpaths - Winwick Lane - footpath - Kenyon Lane - footpath - East Lancs - Red Lion

Join or leave as you wish. To join part way round, make your way via Moss Lane to the railway crossing (Highfield Moss side) for 11:15

Stout footwear and waterproofs essential: conditions on Highfield Moss and return footpaths may be difficult. This is a guided walk: participants must take responsibility for their own safety.
