

BREAKDOWN OF OBJECTIONS

I had to request this information twice because, as I said in my second e-mail to them:

Thanks for the reply, but you have missed out... point 4:

"The number of signatories....- eg one person may have written a letter, but it had been signed by everyone in that family etc"

So 113 actual objections, but how many names / signatories in total?

This is their original reply, which states **113** "objections":

Please find below information relating to the objections received to the proposed closures of Lowton and Golborne High Schools and for a new school as requested:

A total of 118 representations - 77 e-mails, 32 letters and 9 DTW questionnaires

5 in support of the Lowton and Golborne Co-operative Learning Partnership:

- member of staff at unknown school,*
- parent of a Golborne High School pupil,*
- parent of a Lowton High School pupil,*
- unknown respondent*
- Lowton resident.*

An emailed response was received after the closing date.

Their second reply, the last 4 lines of which show the true number of "objectors" as actually being **133**:

To clarify, a total of 118 representations were received to the proposals.

I have listed below a breakdown of the representations:

82 objected to the new school

9 objected to the closure of Golborne High School and the new school

6 objected to the closures Lowton and Golborne High Schools and the new school

6 objected to the closure of Golborne High School

5 objected to the closures of Lowton and Golborne High Schools

5 had concerns about the new school

5 were in support of the Lowton and Golborne Co-operative Learning Partnership

18 representations were sent from more than 1 person:

15 from married couples

1 from 3 family members

1 from 2 residents

1 from 3 residents
