I hope I can count on your support.

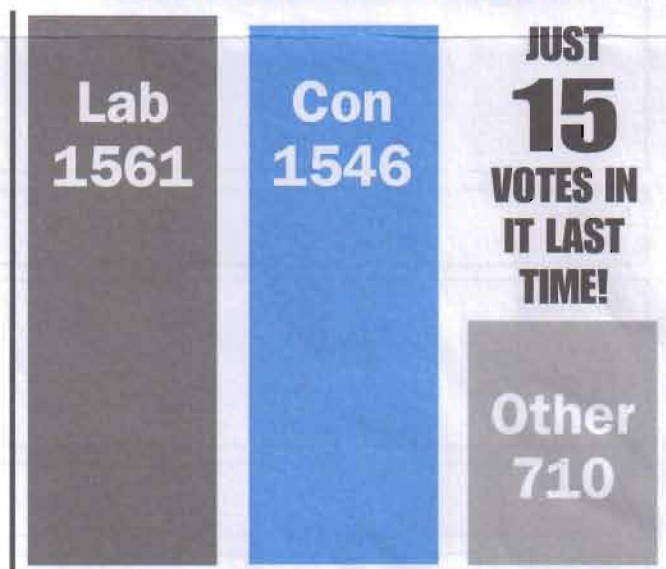
